

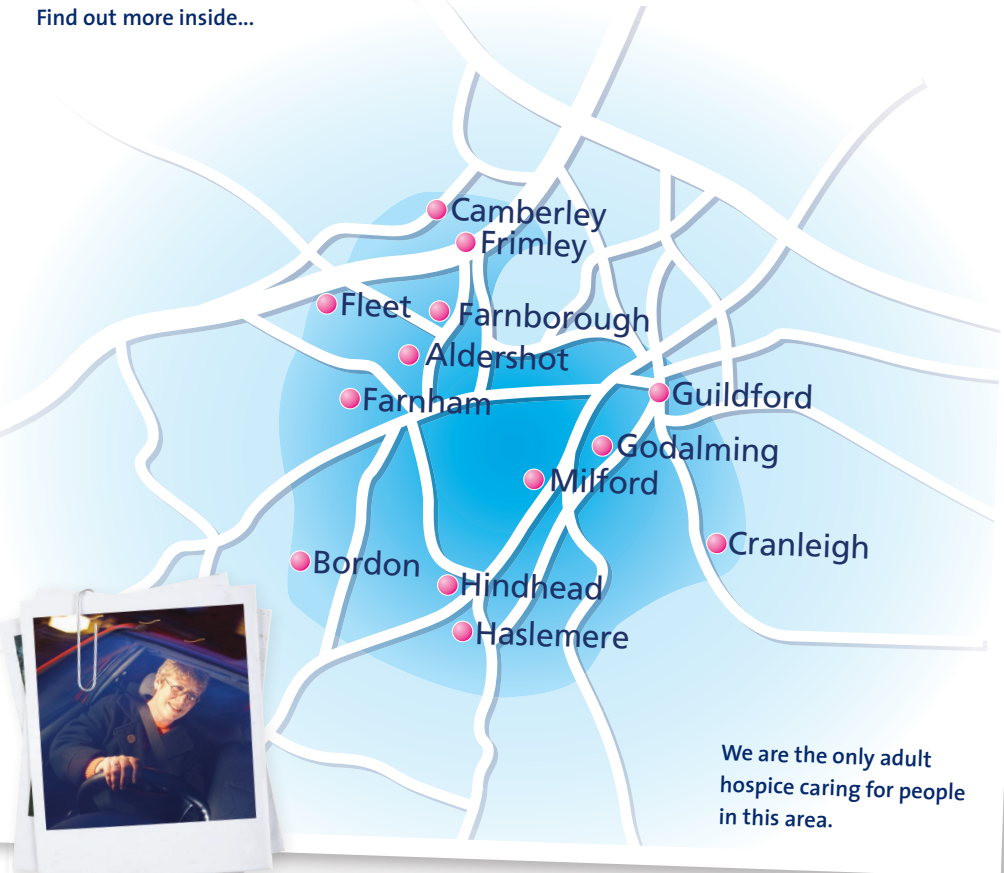
# Will you help people in your local area receive hospice care in their own homes?

I am 28 and a patient at the Hospice. At the age of 25 I was diagnosed with two brain tumours.

The doctors told me I was going to die. I have never known loneliness like it.

I had to leave university and move back to my mum's house in Farnham. I changed so much, physically and emotionally. I was just exhausted and swollen and feeling defeated. I had such beautiful, long dark hair, and it was all falling out. I looked in the mirror and it wasn't me any more. I felt like I'd lost my identity.

The doctors referred me to Phyllis Tuckwell Hospice in February 2009 and I thought it was the end.

What happened next felt like it saved my life. After the devastation of hearing the word 'hospice' had sunk in and I'd made my first terrifying visit, I realised that all these people wanted to help me live, not die!

They have been caring for me at home, where I want to be. I have been visited by my nurses, doctors, occupational therapists, physiotherapists, complementary therapists, social workers and counsellors.

Last year, the Hospice made a promise to aim to help more people like me and my mum, by offering hospice care at home to more patients in their homes. Please think how you could help this promise come true.

My biggest wish is for everyone who needs them to be able to get their help too.

Whatever you choose to do now, please do something... Thank you.
