

Online T34 syringe driver Training – Welcome!

This online module is designed to enable you to gain an understanding of the theory, pre planning and considerations when setting up a syringe driver.

We have used a mix of resources that you will need to work your way through. The whole learning time will take about 3 hours, and the resources remain open to you. Obviously you can start and stop your reading and watching and don't have to go through everything all at once, although we do suggest you follow the order we set to complete the module.

The resources comprise:

PowerPoint presentation to capture expectations and considerations for the patients and family, and your RN NMC accountability as well as calculations.

The video demonstration will guide you through the theory into practice and walk you through setting up the device. Suggest you try and access a T34, syringe, line and water and practice away from the patient area until the summative is completed. Only then be shadowed by another competent colleague within the clinical setting to build confidence further.
