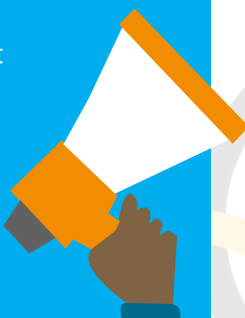


The Warm Up

Firstly you'll need to play with colleagues who work at the same premises as you. By playing only within these arrangements (and not advertising to the general public) you'll avoid the need to register for a Gambling Licence (for more information on running a sweepstake or raffle legally visit the Gambling Commission website).

Arranging the prize! You could offer the winner of the sweepstake a percentage of the money raised from the game, with the rest being donated to Phyllis Tuckwell, or give them a non-monetary prize of your choice, such as a bottle of wine or box of chocolates, and donate the entire proceeds of the game to Phyllis Tuckwell (you can deduct reasonable expenses for prizes).

Get people involved! Spread the word about your fundraising sweepstake via newsletters or over video call at a meeting. Try to aim for 45 sweepstake players, one for each sport; if you have less than 45 players you can opt to give people more than one sport, but these should be split equally and could result in some sports not being assigned.



Go for Gold

Choose who will get each sport by pulling names out of a hat using our handy cut-out sheet.

Sit back, follow and enjoy the games together.

The participant whose event claims the most Team GB Medals will win the prize.

When the games are over, you can give your winning sweepstake player their prize! If you haven't already, you can then also make your donation to Phyllis Tuckwell from the proceeds of your sweepstake.
