Snowman Knitting Pattern

Thank you so much for downloading this knitting pattern. We are delighted that you would like to support Phyllis Tuckwell this Christmas!

We would love for you to knit as many snowmen as you'd like to, which we will then stuff with Cadbury Chocolate Puds and sell to raise money for our hospice care. If possible, please test your knits to make sure they can hold a Cadbury Chocolate Pud!

Materials

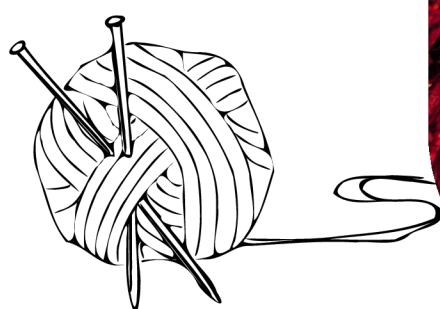
3.25mm Needles

Tapestry Needle

DK Yarn in White, Black and Orange

DK Yarn oddments for hat and scarf

Stuffing



Snowman (White)

Cast on 25 sts

1st Row: K1 (inc 1, K2) to end (33 sts)

2nd Row: (K1, P1) to last st, K1

3rd Row: (P1, K1) to last st, P1

Repeat 2nd and 3rd rows once more

Next Row: st st 10 rows

Next Row: K1 (K2tog) to end (17 sts) then purl 1 row

Next Row: K1 (K2tog) to end (9 sts) then purl 1 row

Next Row: Inc in every stitch (18 sts) then purl 1 row

Next Row: (K1 inc 1) to end (27 sts) then st st 7 rows

Next Row: K1 (K2tog) to end (14 sts), then purl 1 row

Next Row: K2tog to end (7 sts)

B&T, stitch row ends together, fill head with stuffing, but do not gather around neck stitches

Hat

Using colour of choice, cast on 28 sts

Rows 1-4: Begin with a wrong side row i.e. purl and st st for 7 rows

Row 8: K2 K2tog to end (21 sts)

Row 9: Purl to end

Row 10: (K1, K2tog) to end (14 sts)

Break yarn thread through all sts and pull tightly, fasten off and sew seams

Pom Pom

Wind same colour yarn around 2 fingers 20 times

Tie the centre with strong thread

Cut the loops open, trim to shape and attach to hat

You need to create the face before you secure the hat to the head



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Scarf

Using same colour yarn as hat cast on 4 sts

Every row knit until long enough to tie around neck, leave a long thread

Scarf Tassels

Using the long thread backstitch along short edges leaving a loop every other stitch, cut loop to make tassel

Eyes (Black)

Work a French knot for each eye. Thread tapestry needle with black yarn and bring it up from the back where you want the eye to be. Wrap yarn around the needle x2 pushing needle through to the back leaving knot on surface.

Mouth (Black)

Embroider using small back stitches

Nose (Orange)

Repeat French knot and repeat if you want a bigger nose

Buttons (Black)

French knots x2 or create your own

To finish off, gather around neck stitches to create neck and tie off.

Sew hat in place and tie scarf in place.
