Walk for the Wards 2019 - Terms & Conditions of event registration

Thank you for your interest in this year's Walk for the Wards. Please read the terms and conditions below before registering. For further, more detailed information, please also read the FAQs.

- Walk for the Wards 2019 is a walk for all the family, starting and ending at More House School in Frensham.
- All participants aged 16 or under must be accompanied by an adult participant who has signed a Guardian's Declaration taking responsibility for them. If applicants are 17 or 18 years old, they may walk unaccompanied but an adult must have signed the declaration giving them permission to take part.
- The registration fee is £15 for adults, £7 for children aged 14 or under. All entry fees are non-refundable.
- The closing date for online registration is Friday 31st May 2019 at midday. You will still be able to enter on the day but the price will be £17 per adult and £9 for children aged 14 or under.
- Think carefully about which distance route you feel able to complete. Please be aware that both routes contain uneven ground, stiles, heathland and gentle hills. This route also runs next to Frensham Pond. In warm weather, adders may appear in the heathland areas. Please be vigilant and ensure dogs and children keep to the paths. In the unlikely event of a snake bite, please report immediately to your nearest marshal. First Aid cover will be present at this event. Please also be aware that the routes meet and cross several roads and it is the participant's own responsibility to decide when it is safe to cross the road.
- Once registered, you will be sent your registration letter. Please bring this letter with you on the day.
- All participants must sign the declaration on the registration form in order to take part. For online registration, your payment automatically confirms you have read these terms and conditions and accept them in their entirety.
- Participants agree that you enter this event at your own risk and you will not hold Phyllis Tuckwell Hospice Care (the charity and limited company) responsible. Please bring and wear suitable clothing and footwear and follow the directions at all times – we have signage and marshals marking the route.
- Phyllis Tuckwell Hospice Care (the charity and limited company) reserves the right to cancel the event at any time. Your registration fee will remain non-refundable.
- Phyllis Tuckwell Hospice Care (the charity and limited company) reserves the right to refuse entry to any person we deem unfit to take part in the walk.
- The route is sadly unsuitable for wheelchairs or pushchairs.
- Dogs are welcome on the walk, but will not be allowed into More House School.
- By taking part, you understand that photographs of walkers may be taken and you consent to their use for publicity purposes to promote Phyllis Tuckwell Hospice Care.
