

## FAQs for Summer Cinema Nights

### **What ratings are the films?**

Both films are rated 15 so we will not be permitting anyone deemed to be under this age. Please bear this in mind before purchasing tickets.

### **Is there an age limit?**

Yes. The age limit is 15 years and over due to the BBFC ratings of each film

### **Can I bring alcohol?**

Yes please bring your own alcohol but there will be a bar at the venue serving drinks with all proceeds going to Phyllis Tuckwell.

### **Can I bring food?**

Yes, please bring a picnic. Refreshments will be available on the night for you to purchase.

### **What time does the film start/end?**

The films will not begin until the sun has set and it's dark enough that the screen can be seen. This will be approximately 8:30pm. Both films should be finished by 10:30pm

### **Where is it?**

The screenings will take place at Merrist Wood College, Holly Lane, Worplesdon, Guildford, GU3 3PE.

### **Where can I park?**

Parking is available at Merrist Wood College and will be signposted on the day.

### **Can I bring a gazebo/parasol/BBQs/umbrellas?**

No. Please do not bring anything that could potentially block the view of someone behind you. BBQs and other cooking equipment is strictly prohibited.

### **Can I bring a table?**

You are welcome to bring a small table but please take care to not obstruct the view of others around you.

### **How much are tickets?**

Tickets are £15 per person, per film available from [shop.pth.org.uk](http://shop.pth.org.uk). You can also buy tickets by calling the Fundraising Office on 01252 729446 between 9am – 5pm, Monday to Friday.

### **How will I receive my ticket?**

Tickets will be emailed out to you. Please print this email and bring it with you on the night to exchange it for a wrist band which will be provided as you enter the premises.

### **What if it rains?**

The show will go ahead regardless of rain. If the wind is higher than 25 knots then the event will have to be cancelled due to safety concerns. We will be keeping an eye on the weather and will notify you if this is the case.

Please come prepared for all weathers. It's remarkable how chilly it can get when sat in a field watching a film so please wear layers and bring blankets.

### **What time can we arrive?**

Gates open at 7pm. Please arrive anytime from then.

### **What if I arrive late?**

It's no problem to arrive late, please just be aware of others around you as you sit to watch the film. We will ask you to join the back of the crowd to avoid disturbance.

### **Can I buy food and drink with a card or cash?**

There will be refreshments and drinks available to purchase with cash only.



**Is audience participation during The Rocky Horror Picture Show permitted?**

Yes! We're strongly encouraging you to dress up and embrace the themes of the film however please note that you are not permitted to throw rice, confetti, playing cards, toast, water, party poppers or anything that may damage the venue or affect the venue. Phyllis Tuckwell reserves the right to ask tickets holder to leave the premises should they be seen to be throwing any item that could damage equipment or other guests.

**Can you buy tickets on the door?**

Yes but we reserve the right to charge a higher amount for tickets sold on the door. If the event sells out ahead of the date then we will not be selling tickets on the door. Keep an eye out on our Facebook page for this information.

**Will chairs be provided?**

No. Please bring anything you require for comfortable viewing, taking care to not obstruct others view of the screen. We would recommend deck chairs, camping chairs and blankets.

**Can I come in a wheelchair?**

Yes this event is suitable for wheelchairs however this may prove difficult if we've had wet weather in the lead up to the event.

**Can I bring my dog?**

No this event is not suitable for dogs or other pets.

**Can I dress up?**

Yes please do! Both films lend themselves well to themes so please embrace these!

**Will there be an interval?**

No, the film will be shown in its entirety in one sitting.

**Are tickets refundable if I can't make the screening?**

No. Unfortunately all tickets are non-refundable.

**Will I receive headphones?**

No. The screen and equipment will be loud enough for all to hear without the use of headphones.

**Is smoking permitted?**

No. Merrist Wood is a smoke free zone. If you need to smoke we will kindly ask you to leave the premises.

**What refreshments will be provided?**

Yes there will be a selection of cinema related refreshments available on the night; a percentage of whose profits will come to Phyllis Tuckwell.

**Can I buy alcohol on the night?**

Yes. Ale, cider and lager from Hogs Back Brewery will be on sale as well as red and white wine and Prosecco. Should you require anything else we would suggest you bring it with you. Please note that the sale from the wine will come directly to Phyllis Tuckwell.
