A Time to Remember

what is this?

We recognise how important it is for the bereaved to have different ways of expressing their feelings. For some, the opportunity to attend a short service at the Hospice can help.

what happens at this service?

At the service, the Chaplain will read the names of those who have died.

is transport to the venue available?

There is public transport to both sites as well as some on-site parking. You can be dropped off, or there are facilities for family members to stay and enjoy refreshments. Some volunteer driver transport is available, but we have limited capacity, so if this is required please ask and we will try to help.

when are the services held?

Six months after your loved one has died, you will receive an invitation to join us and others who have lost someone special, at a service of remembrance.

do I have to pay for services from Phyllis Tuckwell?

No, all services offered by Phyllis Tuckwell are free. As a charity we are dependent on the local community for their generosity and financial support. We only receive 20% of our funding from the NHS/Government and therefore we have to raise over £20,000 a day to provide all our services.
