



Gifts in Kind

What is 'Gift in Kind'?

A 'Gift in Kind' is a donation of either goods required or services in lieu of a donation of money. The goods are often low value items which a company has been able to source at a lower price than normal before donating to us.

Some examples of recent Gifts in Kind include:

- A sofa bed from Vale Furnishers in Farnham
- A camera and printer from ISS Computers in Cranleigh
- Piano Tuning for our Day Care centre, by Gary Payne Piano Tuning Services of Farnborough
- Felt tip pens and art materials from Stabilo

We are still in need of more items:

- Art materials for our Little Rays group (children aged 5-12 yrs who receive counselling after losing a parent under our care)
- An integral air conditioning unit in the kitchen area of our Hospice coffee shop

Where we receive a Gift in Kind, we are required by The Charities Commission to record the item and the value of the goods or service received.

As a thank you for all Gifts in Kind, we make sure that the donor is thanked publicly through our social media pages. These are seen by our followers and are therefore great publicity for donors.
